New Jersey Combined Property Tax Relief Application



Application for Property Tax Relief (Form PAS-1)

- P.L.2023, c.75 and P.L. 2024, c.88
 - Establishes new Stay NJ program and requires a combined application to apply for:
 - Property Tax Reimbursement (Senior Freeze)
 - ANCHOR
 - Stay NJ



2024 Form PAS-1 Filing Basics

- Filed by 65/over or receiving SSD
 - Homeowners
 - Mobile homeowners
 - Renters
- A One-Stop Filing
 - PAS-1 replaces PTR-1, PTR-2, and ANCHOR
 - Division determines the benefit(s)
 - Annual statement sent to applicants showing amount(s)



Form PAS-1 Filing Basics (cont'd)

- Availability
 - PDF of application available online early February;
 - Online version being developed also expected in February;
 - Mailing is expected late February/early March;
 - Re-mail date TBD.
- Filing Deadline October 31, 2025



About the Programs

- Senior Freeze still offers reimbursement of property tax increase
- ANCHOR offers rebate amount depending on income/ownership
- Stay NJ offers 50% of property taxes with a \$6,500 max
- All benefits are subject to budget appropriations

Applicant will receive the **greater** of Stay NJ or the combined Senior Freeze/ANCHOR amount



Program Eligibility Requirements



2024 PTR Eligibility Guidelines

- Age 65/older or receiving federal Social Security disability
 - By 12/31/23
- Owned and lived in the home (3-Years)
 - Since 12/31/20
- Total annual income must have been
 - For 2023: \$163,050 or less, and
 - For 2024: \$168,268 or less



Returning PTR Claimants

Eligible returning claimants must complete the combined Application for Property Tax Relief once it becomes available.

Claimants:

- Will receive the combined application with the pre-printed base year
- Must verify that they met the 2024 eligibility requirements
- Will be reimbursed the difference of 2024 and the base year

For tax years 2023 and prior, the application was Form PTR-2.



2024 ANCHOR Eligibility

• October 1, 2024 residency requirement

Homeowners ANCHOR Benefit Amounts

2024 Gross Income	65/Over	SSD Recipient
\$150,000 or less	\$1,750	\$1,500
\$150,001 - \$250,000	\$1,250	\$1,000

Mobile Home/Renters ANCHOR Benefit Amounts

2024 Gross Income	65/Over	SSD Recipient
\$150,000 or less	\$700	\$450



Stay NJ Eligibility

- Age 65 and older;
- New Jersey resident homeowner for full tax year; and
- Income for the prior year of less than \$500,000
- Benefit of 50% of property taxes billed (up to \$6,500)



Single Combined Application

- Paper Version
 - Page 1 collects basic taxpayer information;
 - Directs filer to the section(s) they need to complete;
 - No direct deposit option.
- Online App
 - A series of yes/no questions;
 - Filer only sees the questions relevant to them;
 - Direct deposit permitted;
 - Replaces the existing online ANCHOR and PTR filing options;
 - Will integrate ID.me for some filers.



Gross Income (P.L. 2023, c. 75 & P.L.2024, c.88)

- Total income reported on Form NJ-1040;
- Tax-exempt interest;
- Distributions from or roll overs to a Roth IRA;
- Other retirement income excluded from taxation; and
- Social Security.



Timeline

- February 2025 Applications become available
- June 2025 FY26 State Budget Passed
 - First time we can be sure what is funded
- July 15, 2025 Senior Freeze portion issued
- September 15, 2025 ANCHOR portion issued
- February 2026 1st quarter of Stay benefit issued
 - 2025 PAS-1 mailed
- May 2026 2nd quarter of Stay benefit issued



Timeline (*subject to FY27 budget appropriations)

- June 2026 FY27 State Budget Passed
 - Will remaining 2024 Stay benefit be funded?
- July 15, 2026 2025 Senior Freeze portion issued*
- Summer 2026 3rd quarter of 2024 Stay benefit*
- September 15, 2026 2025 ANCHOR portion issued*
- November 2026 4th quarter of 2024 Stay benefit issued*
- February 2027 1st quarter of 2025 Stay benefit issued*
 - 2026 PAS-1 mailed
- May 2027 2nd quarter of Stay issued*



New: Annual Notice of Benefits

- Required to notify applicants with an explanation of benefits annually:
 - Property taxes amount used to determine benefits;
 - Senior Freeze benefit amount;
 - ANCHOR benefit;
 - Stay NJ benefit;
 - Net reduction in property taxes.
